Unused and/or expired medication (prescription and over-the-counter) needs to be disposed of properly. There is a **free** drop-off site located in the basement of the Chisago County Courthouse.

ANIMALS AT LARGE—COMPLAINTS OF DOGS RUNNING LOOSE

City hall receives complaints about owners letting their dogs run loose. The city code reads as follows:

“506.08 **RESTRAINT OF DOGS** No dog shall be permitted to be at large in the city. All dogs shall be under restraint at all times.”

“506.01 **DEFINITIONS**

- c. At Large. A dog shall be termed at large when it is not under restraint, as defined herein.
- d. Restraint. A dog is under restraint if it is controlled by a leash not exceeding eight feet in length or if it is within the boundaries of the owner's or harbor's premises. (07-2010)

Please refer to the Shafer City Codes which can be found on the city's website or see a copy of the Code Book at City Hall for the full ordinance regarding animals

Get some Neighborhood Pride - There have been complaints made to the city about people having trash and parking in their yards in several areas of the city. Be considerate of your neighbors and take pride in the appearance of your property. Having trash in your yard could become a health or safety hazard and be subject to citations.
