POSITION TITLE: Director Public Works Water and Sewer
Operator/Maintenance

REPORTS TO: Mayor – Assistant Mayor

SUPERVISES: Public Works/Maintenance Employees

BASIC FUNCTION: Provide for the maintenance, repair and operation of the City's water, sewer and storm-water sewer systems and wastewater treatment facilities. To perform maintenance and repair duties for City's streets and infrastructure, parks, property, buildings and equipment.

LICENSES REQUIRED: Class "D" Waste Water
Class "D" Water
Class "B" CDL

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

1. WATER SYSTEM

- A. Operate and maintain water wells, water tower reservoir, water pumps and pump-houses, water mains, water meters, fire hydrants, etc.
 - a. Meet all State reporting and testing requirements
 - b. Provide safe, adequate water supply
 - c. Provide for inspections and repair of water system
 - d. Monitor water system and maintain records
 - e. Provide maintenance of water system
 - f. Provide/monitor service taps into water main
 - g. Monitor service water line repairs/installation
 - h. Provide maintenance of water meters
 - i. Read water meters and maintain reading records
 - j. Provide maintenance of water tower lights
 - k. Shut-off/turn-on water service to private properties
 - l. Maintain, repair, keep accessible and flush fire hydrants

2. SANITARY SEWER

- A. Operate and maintain sanitary sewer lift stations, sewer mains, manholes, pumps, etc.
 - a. Provide for operation of lift stations
 - b. Provide for inspection and repairs of sewer system
 - c. Monitor sewer system and maintain records
 - d. Provide maintenance of sewer system
 - e. Monitor service line repairs/installation
 - f. Provide for entry into confined spaces
 - g. Inspect and maintain manholes

3. WASTEWATER TREATMENT PONDS

- A. Operate and maintain wastewater treatment ponds and infrastructure.
 - a. Meet all State reporting and testing requirements
 - b. Provide for operation of pond system
 - c. Discharge ponds
 - d. Provide for repair of wastewater ponds system
 - e. Provide maintenance of wastewater pond system
 - f. Monitor wastewater ponds and maintain records
 - g. Maintain mowing of pond property
 - h. Maintain access road to pond property

4. STORM-WATER SEWER SYSTEM

- A. Maintain a free-flowing storm-water sewer system
 - a. Inspect and monitor storm-water sewer system
 - b. Provide for repair of storm-water sewer system
 - c. Provide maintenance of storm-sewer system and ditches

5. STREETS AND STREET INFRASTRUCTURE

- A. Repair and maintain city streets, city driveways, parking areas, sidewalks, boulevards, street lights, street signs, equipment, etc.
 - a. Provide for repair of city streets

- b. Provide snowplowing and sanding of city streets
- c. Provide for sweeping of city streets
- d. Provide maintenance of city streets
- e. Provide striping of city streets
- f. Monitor city streets and maintain records
- g. Provide maintenance and repair for city driveways
- h. Provide snowplowing of city driveways/parking areas
- i. Provide maintenance of city sidewalks/hall entry ramp
- l. Provide snow shoveling and salt on city sidewalks/ramp
- m. Monitor and maintain records of city sidewalks
- n. Monitor street lights for light replacement and repair
- o. Report to NSP for light replacement and repair
- p. Provide mowing and maintenance of city boulevards
- q. Plant and maintain city boulevard trees and plants
- r. Provide maintenance of city street signs
- s. Provide repair/replacement of city street signs
- t. Provide maintenance of city equipment
- u. Provide basic repair or arrange repair of city equipment
- v. Monitor equipment and maintain records
- w. Provide safe operation of city equipment
- x. Assist City Weed Inspector
- y. Remove weeds/grass from private property

6. CITY PARKS

- A. Inspect, maintain and repair city parks and parks equipment and ice rink.
 - a. Provide maintenance of city parks and park equipment
 - b. Provide for repair of city park equipment
 - c. Provide mowing and snow removal for city parks
 - d. Perform flooding and snow removal for city ice rink
 - e. Plant and maintain trees and plants at city parks
 - f. Monitor and inspect city parks and equipment for safety
 - g. Maintain records

7. CITY PROPERTY

- A. Maintain and repair city property and city compost
 - a. Provide maintenance of city property
 - b. Provide for repair of city property
 - c. Provide set-up and removal of city decorations
 - d. Maintain city compost
 - e. Open compost to public

8. CITY BUILDINGS

- A. Maintenance, including cleaning, repair of city buildings and building contents and furniture and equipment moving and set-up.
 - a. Provide for maintenance of city buildings
 - b. Perform cleaning of city buildings
 - c. Provide for repair of city buildings
 - d. Provide for maintenance and repair of building contents
 - e. Perform moving of city buildings furniture/equipment

f. Provide set-up and removal of election equipment

9. CITY EQUIPMENT

A. Repair and maintenance, including record keeping, and requests/reports for city equipment.

- a. Provide basic repair or arrange repair of city equipment
- b. Provide maintenance of city equipment
- c. Monitor equipment and maintain records
- d. Provide reports on status of city equipment
- e. Provide written requests for city equipment purchases
- f. Provide cost estimates for equipment repairs/purchases
- g. Safely operate motorized/non-motorized city equipment

10. OTHER ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

A. Physical demands, environment, emergencies, responsibilities, personal attributes, etc.

- a. Walking, holding, pushing, pulling, bending, climbing
- b. Lifting up to 75 pounds
- c. Seeing, hearing, contact with loud noise
- d. Ability to wear and use safety equipment
- e. Ability to work in varied/extreme weather conditions
- f. Ability to work with raw sewage/hazardous materials
- g. Ability to work at high elevations
- h. Ability to work in confined spaces
- i. Ability to be on call for emergencies
- j. Ability to work overtime for emergencies
- k. Required compensatory time-off in lieu of overtime pay
- l. Required probationary period of 6 months
- m. Responsible to Mayor or designated council-member
- n. Responsible for reporting city ordinance violations
- o. Responsible for upholding city ordinances
- p. Ability to take directions and act accordingly
- r. Ability to work alone responsibly
- s. Ability to deal with public and public issues
- t. Problem solving ability
- u. Able to read, write and do math
- v. Able to attend meetings outside of normal work hours
